

Fish/Duck Pond

You'll need:

- An inflatable or plastic wading pool
- Floating plastic fish or rubber ducks
- Flexible magnetic strips that can be cut into pieces with scissors (available at craft or hardware stores)
- Scissors
- Permanent marker
- Sticks, two-to-three-feet long
- String

Set up and play:

- Write a different number on the bottom of each fish or duck with the permanent marker. Write numbers on the prizes that match the numbers on the floating objects.
- Stick a piece of magnetic strip on the top of each floating object, above water level.
- To make the fishing pole, tie a piece of string to one end of each stick. On the other end of the string, attach a piece of magnetic strip.
- Fill the pool with water to make a "pond."
- Players "catch" a fish or duck with their fishing pole and win the prize that matches the number on it.
