

MDA Carnival Web Site Privacy Policy

MDA encourages the interactive nature of online media and we strive to safeguard the privacy of individuals who use the MDA Web site. Children under the age of 18 must obtain their parents' consent before entering any information on the MDA Web site.

WHAT INFORMATION IS COLLECTED?

At MDA, it's our policy to create Web site content that requires minimum collection of information from all of our visitors, including children. Generally, MDA limits the identifiable information collected from children to their name, address, city, state, zip code, e-mail address and parent/guardian e-mail address.

MDA COMMUNICATIONS

When a parent/guardian accepts the Terms and Conditions on behalf of his/her child, he/she agrees that he/she and his/her child may receive future communications from MDA and the child may provide MDA with his/her identifiable information. Within ten business days of receiving this information, we send the child's parent/guardian a notification e-mail advising of the child's request to receive information from MDA on the Carnival Program and give the parent/guardian the option to have the child's information removed from MDA's database. At any time, the parent/guardian has the opportunity to request that MDA cease communications with the child and delete the child's information from our database by following the "unsubscribe" instructions. In addition, parents/guardians may at any time review any identifiable information collected about their child (see below, Parental Consent & Access).

All identifiable information collected about children is used by MDA only in connection with the MDA Carnival Program and is not shared with third parties.

PARENTAL CONSENT & ACCESS

At MDA, our goal is to help parents/guardians ensure that their kids have a safe and fun online experience. That's why we've set up a system by which parents/guardians can print out and mail, fax or e-mail us a signed consent form that allows them to review all identifiable information collected about their child, have this information deleted, and/or request that there be no further collection or use of their child's information.

You as a parent/guardian also have the right to review all identifiable information relating to your child that may be collected by MDA. Please e-mail to MDA your request to inspect your child's identifiable information at mdacarnival@mdausa.org, or write to MDA at:
